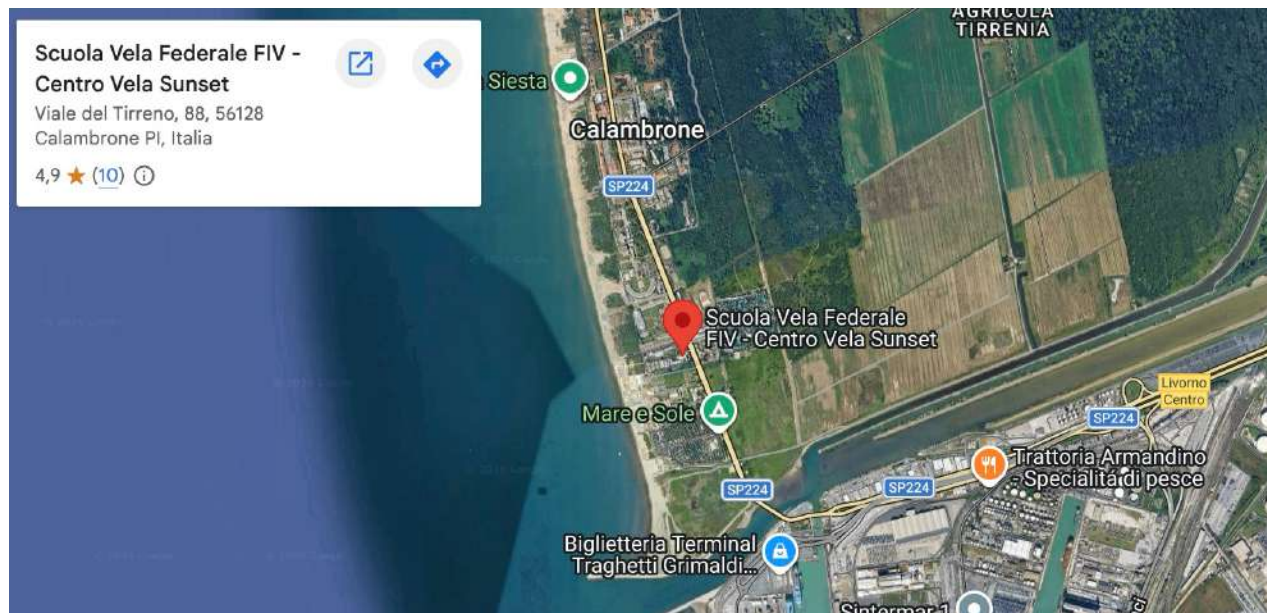


# WORLD CHAMPIONSHIP A-CLASS CATAMARANS

## Calambrone, sea, wind and hospitality

**Calambrone**, on the coastline between Tirrenia and Livorno, combines a long maritime tradition with a coastal area that has recently undergone major regeneration, featuring wide sandy beaches with fine sand, coastal dunes, restored historic buildings and the nearby Tombolo pinewood, which forms part of the San Rossore Natural Park.

Exposure to winds and wave motion makes this location particularly suitable for water sports, sailing and windsurfing, qualities that make it consistent with a major international event dedicated to A-Class catamarans.

During the indicated week, typical local thermal winds are expected: from the east in the morning and from the northwest in the afternoon.



The attached site plan clearly identifies the **CATAMARAN AREA** on the seafront, the **PARKING AREAS FOR TRAILERS AND CARS**, and the **CAMPING PINETA** directly opposite.



Within the facility, apartments are available in multiple configurations



This layout suggests a favorable organizational set-up, with direct access to the beach, areas dedicated to moving boats and equipment, and an immediate relationship between launching area, reception and support services.

The entire complex can accommodate up to 150 catamarans and their related equipment (cars, trailers, etc.).



The environmental system of dunes and pinewood is one of the most recognizable features of the area and contributes to the landscape value of the event.



Aerial views of the coastline also highlight the coexistence of beach, accommodation facilities and services, which is useful for hosting sailors, accompanying persons and spectators.

Calambrone is a seaside destination of interest for both sports and family tourism: the coast offers wide beaches, a dune landscape and an environment of high natural value, while the restoration of the former holiday camps has helped raise the overall quality of local hospitality.

The position between Pisa and Livorno is an additional strategic advantage for participants and accompanying persons, as it allows easy access to the coastline, the port of Livorno and the wider area's service network.

For an international sporting event, Calambrone can therefore present itself not only as a technical regatta venue, but also as a destination for a stay of relaxation and discovery of the Tuscan coast.

Among the facilities indicated, **Camping Pineta** is particularly well suited to the sailing event, as it is located about 300 metres from the club and may be especially convenient for crews, accompanying persons and enthusiasts seeking an informal, functional solution close to the championship's operational area.

Centro Vela Sunset also offers a large swimming pool with a dedicated bar area, ideal for relaxing after racing.

The A-Class Catamaran World Championship finds in Calambrone its natural venue: a wide and windy coastline, set between beach, dunes and pinewood, with widespread tourist services and a spatial organization that is highly favorable for regatta logistics.

The event layout shows a catamaran area directly overlooking the sea, integrated with parking areas, access roads and support services, in a context where sailing culture is already well rooted thanks also to the presence of the Federal Sailing School and facilities dedicated to water sports.

Alongside the sporting event, the surrounding area offers various accommodation options: apartments and residences for independent stays, hotels for more traditional hospitality, a campsite equipped with bungalows and pitches, and seaside tourist complexes that are part of the coastal redevelopment process.
